



## **Franklin Community High School – Boys “All School Team” Late Fall League**

### **1. October 29<sup>th</sup> – December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016**

- A. Game dates will be – Oct. 29, Nov. 5, 12, 26, Dec. 3, 10 \*\*\*NO GAMES ON NOV. 19<sup>th</sup> \*\*\*
- B. Each team will play two (2) games each Saturday during the 6-week period.
- C. Each team will be guaranteed 12 games
- D. Games will be played at Franklin Community High School and if needed surrounding schools.

### **2. Eligible Teams**

- A. School Teams
- B. Teams consisting of players that attend the same Elementary School
- C. Teams consisting of players that all feed into the same High School (Feeder teams)
- D. Boys teams in Grades – 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th Grade (Based on school year 2016-17)
- E. All Star or Travel Teams will be allowed to play, however, you must play up 1 grade level.

### **3. Entry Fee and Schedule Information**

- A. \$375 per team
- B. To secure a spot in the league, teams must submit entry form and fee by Oct. 19, 2016.
- C. The schedule will be released Monday, Oct. 24 at 8pm. online at [www.midwestyouthtournaments.com](http://www.midwestyouthtournaments.com) and our tourney app (Midwest Youth Tournaments). Schedules will also be emailed out to the email address listed on the registration form.

#### 4. Admission for spectators will be as follows:

Adults - \$5  
Students 6-18 - \$3  
Children 5 & under – Free

#### 5. Registration and Roster Information

- A. Teams must submit registration with entry fee by Oct. 19, 2016.
- B. A completed roster must be submitted to Midwest Youth Tournaments by the start of the first game on the first week of play, Oct. 29.
- C. In no instance may a player be added to the roster after the league begins without approval from Midwest Youth Tournaments.
- D. Although birth certificates and report cards are not required to be submitted.... teams should have these available should a protest occur questioning a player's grade and age.
- E. Should a player be found to be ineligible for the league in which he is playing, the following will apply:
  - a. Player may not continue playing in the league nor be allowed to participate on any team for the remainder of the league.
  - b. All games that the player has participated in will be forfeited. The team will be allowed to continue in the league without the ineligible player moving forward.

#### 6. Kentuckiana State Championships – All School State Tourney

All teams participating in the "All School Team" League are eligible to participate in the Midwest Youth Tournaments School Team "Kentuckiana State Championships" held the first week of March in Floyds Knobs IN at a reduced entry fee of \$200 (tourney fee: \$225). Over 100 teams!! The tournament is a 3 Game Guarantee – 2 Pool Games with all teams advancing to a seeded single elimination tournament.
