



## Midwest Youth Tournaments – “All School Team” Travel League

### 1. Game Dates: October 27 – December 8, 2019

- A. Games dates are: Oct. 27, Nov. 3, 10, 17, 24, Dec. 8 \*\*\*NO GAMES DEC. 1st\*\*\*
- B. Each team will play two (2) games each Sunday during 6-week period.
- C. 12 Game league
- D. Game times will be played between 11:00am and 6:00pm

### 2. Eligible Teams

- A. Boys and Girls School Teams – 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th Grade (Based on school year 2019-20)
  - a. 2nd Boys will be offered if we get 5 teams. 3rd and 4th Girls may be combined.
- B. Teams consisting of players that attend the same Elementary School
- C. Teams consisting of players that all feed into the same High School (Feeder teams)
- D. All Star or Travel Teams will be allowed to play, however, they must play up 1 grade level.

### 4. Entry Fee, Registration, and Schedule Information

- A. \$375 per team
- B. To secure a spot in the league, teams must submit registration by Oct. 14, 2019.
- C. The schedule will be released to our app (Midwest Youth Tournaments) and online at [www.midwestyouthtournaments.com](http://www.midwestyouthtournaments.com) and emailed out by Tuesday at 8:00pm on Oct. 22, 2019.

## 5. Hosting Information

- A. Each participating team has the ability to host the league for a minimum of (1) one Sunday during league play with access to (2) two gymnasiums from approximately 11:00am to 6:00pm.
- B. Teams participating in the league that are outside the recommended maximum driving distance for teams to travel may lose their ability to act as a “Host Team.”
- C. The first (6) six teams in each division that sign up and want to host will be awarded a host site date.

## 6. Host Team Responsibilities

- A. Schedule qualified officials
- B. Compensate officials
- C. Supply Clock Keepers
- D. Schedule gate workers
- E. Schedule concession workers.
- F. Host Team will receive all profits from gate receipts and concessions sold. Each host team will have the ability to more than cover their league entry fee plus make a profit for their team. Total profits will depend largely upon the ability of the hosting team to secure volunteers/parents that are willing to work for the team.

Note: If volunteer officials are used they must be approved by a Midwest Youth Tournaments staff member.

## 7. Admission

- A. The following established admission prices must be used by Host Teams:

Adults - \$5

Students 6-18 - \$4

Children 5 & under – Free

## 8. Registration and Roster Information

- A. Teams must submit registration with entry fee by Oct. 14, 2019.
- B. A completed roster must be submitted to Midwest Youth Tournaments by the start of the first game on Week 1.
- C. Players may be added to the roster after the league begins only with MYT approval.
- D. Although birth certificates and report cards are not required to be submitted, teams should have documentation available should a protest occur questioning a player's grade and age.
- E. Should a player be found to be ineligible for the league in which he or she is playing, the following will apply:
  - a. Player may not continue playing in the league nor be allowed to participate on any team or any leagues operated by Midwest Youth Tournaments for the current league season.
  - b. All games that the player has participated in will be forfeited. The team will be allowed to continue in league play without the player.
